



EXCHANGE AGREEMENT

between

GORGAN UNIVERSITY OF AGRICULTURAL SCIENCES AND NATURAL RESOURCES and

HOCHSCHULE RHEIN-WAAL

(RHINE-WAAL UNIVERSITY OF APPLIED SCIENCES), GERMANY

In accordance with our mutual interests in academic exchanges, and for the purpose of establishing a mutually beneficial collaboration,

GORGAN UNIVERSITY OF AGRICULTURAL SCIENCES AND NATURAL RESOURCES, Shahid Beheshti Ave., 49138-15739, Gorgan, Iran, hereinafter "GUASNR" represented by its acting president DR. ALI NAJAFINEJAD,

and

HOCHSCHULE RHEIN-WAAL (RHINE-WAAL UNIVERSITY OF APPLIED SCIENCES), Marie-Curie-Strasse 1, 47533 Kleve, Germany, hereinafter 'HSRW', represented by its acting president PROF. DR. EBERHARD MENZEL,

enter into the following Agreement.

Article 1- Intention

The purpose of this Agreement is to provide extensive opportunity for inter-institutional exchanges and cooperation between HSRW (Faculty of Life Sciences) and GUASNR. Both Parties agree to promote education and research cooperation between the two Institutions on the basis of mutual respect for their autonomy, with due regard for the prevailing laws and regulations in each country and Institution, and within their available resources.

Article 2 - Areas of cooperation

The two Institutions agree to encourage the following activities:

Exchange of faculty, staff members, and students for research, teaching and study.

Article 3 - Requirements for Student and Staff Exchange

<u>Admission:</u> Participants of the exchange will be screened for eligibility for admission by the home Institution. Both Institutions shall use their best efforts to designate only well-qualified individuals for participation in the exchange. Each Institution shall supply academic background information to the host Institution for each participant.

Student numbers: Student exchanges are based on the understanding that exchanges are matched one-for-one by each institution. However, an exchange of up to 2 students per semester is preferred. Minor imbalances may be agreed upon by mutual consent.

<u>Visa and health insurance</u>: The participants have to adhere to the visa requirements of the host country and need to prove sufficient health insurance. For the enrolment at HSRW, it is a legal requirement to be part of the public student health insurance in Germany. The insurance costs about 90 Euros per month, regardless of provider. Travel insurances cannot be accepted for the enrolment. The International Center assists exchange students in obtaining appropriate health insurance, of course without receiving any commission or the like from any insurance provider.

<u>Language requirements:</u> Students who wish to study at HSRW are required to provide proof that their language proficiency in German or English (depending on the desired programme) is equivalent to at least the B2 level of the Common European Framework (CEF) for bachelor's programmes, or to the C1 level for master's degree programmes. This may be demonstrated by an official language test or a written confirmation from the partner Institution.

<u>Tuition fees/ semester contribution:</u> Students are expected to pay their tuition fees – if applicable - at their home institution and receive a tuition waiver from their guest institution.

Under German law an exemption from the semester contribution (Semesterbeitrag) for the social welfare benefits provided by the Student Welfare Organisation (Studierendenwerk) to the student body at HSRW is not possible. The semester contribution is to be paid on a semesterly basis (twice annually) and covers the student's social service contribution, the aforementioned student body fee, the registration fee and, as the largest component, the Semester Ticket, which entitles the student to the use of regional public transport within North-Rhine Westphalia. The semester contribution is 302,88 EUR for the 2019 summer semester and may increase slightly over time.

Article 6 - Additional Provisions

This Agreement shall become effective as of the date of signature by the representatives of the Institutions. The Agreement may be modified, amended or supplemented in writing by mutual consent at any time.

The Institutions agree to review this Agreement every five years in order to evaluate the progress and improve the quality of the collaboration. The Agreement may be terminated with written notification by each of the Parties. Such notification must be given at least six months in advance of the effective date of termination. Any specific programme then in progress will not be affected.

This Agreement is made in English. Both Institutions have an authentic copy of it.
